**1. Forevergreens**  
11398 Bolton Road, Springville, NY  
716- 560-8004

Forevergreens is located in the Town of Yorkshire and can be reached from Route 39 (Creek Rd). From Route 39 turn south onto Hake Rd/County Rd 556 which becomes Bolton Rd; you will travel 1.5 miles on Bolton and the farm will be on your left.

As the name implies, Forevergreens is a grower of evergreens as well as many other trees available for year-round landscaping, but don't forget the Christmas trees too! Come to the farm to see tree transplanting demonstrations including proper digging and replanting tips. Pick out an evergreen or landscape tree from over 50 varieties including dwarf, weeping trees and slow growing conifers. Evergreens are available from 1' to 15' balled and burlaped, potted and seedlings. Also available are weeping cherry, maples, oaks, crabapple, birches, fruit trees and more. **This farm will be open from 9am-4pm.**

**2. Roundoak Fiber & Yarns**

To reach the Roundoak Fiber & Yarns farm; turn west onto County Rd 43

from State Rte 240 and take the first left on County Rd 43, Stady Rd.

Come visit the farms free ranging chicken flock where eggs are available for purchase. Enjoy viewing their mixed flock of sheep grazing while learning how to spin your own yarn. Roundoak offers raw fleece, roving for spinning (dyed and natural), handspun yarn (dyed and natural) for purchase at the farm along with free spinning lessons. **This farm will be open from 9am-4pm.**



**3. Car- Bu Farms**

The farm is around the corner on Cheeseman Hill Rd. Car-Bu Farms LLC is a modern dairy emphasizing cow comfort and environmental responsibility. The milking herd of 480 Holsteins enjoys sand bedded free-stalls, with fans and misters to keep them cool they respond with over 80 lbs per cow of high quality milk on a 3 times per day milking schedule. Young stock and dry cows have access to pasture as well as stalls bedded with sand from the passive sand separation lane. Car-Bu



Farms LLC is owned and operated by Carl (Butch) and Barb George. Dustin Bliss' milking herd is part of the Car-Bu operation and Dustin is an important part of the management team as he works toward his goal of ownership of this dairy. **4. Elton Greenhouse**

Located in Town of Farmersville, Elton Greenhouse has annuals, perennials, hanging baskets, shrubs, house plants, vegetable plants, seed potatoes, onion sets, etc. They also offer floral arrangements available year round. **The greenhouse will be open from 9am-5pm.**

Located in the Town of Farmersville 2 miles west of Route 98, Raisin Acres uses no hormones or antibiotics and does not feed any animal by-products to their beef and hogs. Their herd is managed on an intensive grazing system that has been practiced since 1993. Natural raised beef and pork available by the half or quarter. **This farm will be open from 10am-2pm.**

At Heartwood Farms you will have the chance to see demonstrations of a working sawmill, maple syrup facilities and



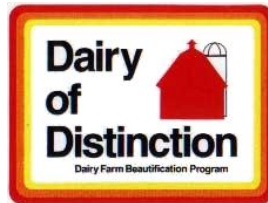
their Morgan horses. Marc and Kathy will have maple products and rough cut

**7. Center Vu Farm**

Farm is located 1/2 mile from Centerville at the intersection of

County Road 36 and Dow road. Owners and operators of the farm Craig & Alice Decker, Chris and Stephanie George welcome you to one of Allegany County's "Dairy of Distinction" farms as designated by the Northeast Dairy Farm Beautification Program. Visitors will be invited to see the barn setup and equipment necessary to operate a family dairy farm. You will see dairy livestock, the amount of forage, grain and water it takes to feed a cow and the average volume of milk produced by a cow each day. **This farm will be open from 10am-2pm.**



**8. Ruebarb Alpacas**

Ruebarb Alpacas has quality alpacas and alpaca products with reasonable pricing. You will be able to meet some of the alpacas on the farm including some cria (baby alpacas) Alpaca products available for purchase include live animals, socks, hats, gloves, mittens, rugs, throws and alpaca yarn, fleece and rovings. These products are made from fiber grown in Allegany County. **This farm will be open from 10am-2pm.**

**9. Wild Geese Farm**

The Wild Geese Farm is located in the Town of Rushford; turn off County 7B/Hardy Corners Rd onto Agett Rd; the farm is a 1/2 mile up on the left. The farm uses a grass-based farming system integrating Angus beef cattle, Shetland sheep, and poultry production. You will be able to see cattle, sheep, layer hens, turkeys and horses at this 52 acre farm. Frozen beef, lamb, and chicken will be available for purchase as well as registered Shetland Breeding Stock. **This farm will be open from 10am-2pm.**



**10. Skyview Farm**

Located in Town of New Hudson, turning off County 7B/Hardy Corners Rd in Rushford onto Mt. Monroe Road, travel 6 miles farm will be on the left.

Farm visitors may pick their own winter squash and watch goat milking demonstrations.

Also come see their goats, sheep and baby kids (goat children) along with hogs raised at Skyview Farm. Products available for sale: hay – round and square bales, lambs (market, 4-H, FFA), goats, pork and vegetables. **This farm will be open from 10am-2pm.**



**11. Fillmore Greenhouse Inc.**

Fillmore Greenhouse is a hydroponics tomato enterprise with fifteen acres under glass. You will see plants over eight feet tall, harvesting and packing processes and learn about where these tomatoes are marketed. **Plant disease transmission is a major concern for this facility. We request that you wear clean (non-gardening) clothes and shoes.** You will be able to purchase

tomatoes. **Tours will be offered at 10:00, 11:30 AM and at 1:00 PM. \*Restroom facilities are available at this location.**

**12. I-Tang-O**

I-Tang-O takes the holistic approach and specializes in placing urban flocks. Educating the public on how to keep chickens in small spaces stems from and adds too the sustainable agriculture lifestyle movement. Knowing where your food comes from, how it was grown and/or how it was raised is important.



The Victory garden now includes Chickens! I-Tang-O also engages in wild crafting- the use of herbs and botanical essential oils are used to make a variety of all natural goat's milk soaps, creams and teas. The I-Tang-O motto is, "If you can't put it in your mouth, don't put it on your skin!" **This farm will be open from 10am-2pm.**
